


Basin Faucet Set **FBF3**



CONFIGURATION

Mains Pressure systems Change the aerator to Mains (supplied).

Unequal Low systems Install as supplied.

Equal Low systems Install as supplied.



INSTALLATION

FOR PRESSURES EXCEEDING 500KPA INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE. THOROUGHLY FLUSH ALL PIPES TO ELIMINATE ANY REMAINING DIRT AND RESIDUE, AND INSTALL INLINE FILTERS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY VOID THE WARRANTY.

Installation must comply with Section 5.4 of AS/NZS 3500 Standard with regard to Isolating stop cock use.

Note: To remove handles the chrome disc needs to be prised out and handle retaining screws undone.

- Before commencing installation, turn off main water supply.
- 30mm hole is required for each tap body and 24mm hole for the spout spigot. The tap bodies may be spaced at between 150mm and 210mm hole centres (cut the breech pipe [item 10] to the correct size).
- Fit and adjust the tap body back nuts so that the breech pipe spigot enters the spout nipple by a minimum of 10mm.
- Fit both tap bodies complete with breech pipe one of two plates and black mounting seal, to Vanity top.
- Fit second black mounting washer, plate and holding nut to each tap body on top of bench.

ATTACH PROOF OF PURCHASE HERE

- The tap body retaining nuts allow for 18-30mm bench thickness. Once bodies are secured to vanity top, fit cover flanges and handles.
- Fit the centre spout with a bead of silicone sealant spread around inner lip of mounting flange.

 Spout base spigot slides on to breech pipe nipple. Fit opaque flat washer (item 2) and flanged back-nut (item 3) underneath.
- Tighten nipple compression fittings.
- Turn on water supply.
- Check for leaks.
