*FOR PRESSURES EXCEEDING 500kPa INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE. THOROUGHLY FLUSH ALL PIPES TO ELIMINATE ANY REMAINING DIRT AND RESIDUE, AND INSTALL INLINE FILTERS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY VOID THE WARRANTY.

- Once the bridging nipple has been cut to length and fitted to the in-wall wing-backs, wind thread tape around the protruding spigot until the thread pitch is barely raised.
- Screw on offsets (item 3) and adjust width to match the faucet body back-nuts (item 1).
- Fit mounting washers (item 2) to the faucet body back-nuts (item 1) and tighten back-nuts on to offsets. NB: Do not over-tighten no thread tape is required.
- Turn on water supply. Check for leaks.

USING THE DIVERTER

The Diverter knob must be lifted up and **twisted** to lock the diverter in place.

The diverter will not remain up automatically. It should then be twisted again to release.
