

### Toilet Handspray Set

Congratulations on your purchase of this high quality product from Foreno Tapware.

Please read the following before installation and retain (along with your receipt) for future reference.

This product must be installed by a suitably qualified tradesperson.

The Foreno Toilet Handspray Set is designed to fit on the wall beside the toilet pan on a wall bracket (supplied), and connects to an isolating cistern tap (not included). The isolating cistern tap connected to the hose must be turned off when the handpiece is not in use.

A suitable Backflow prevention valve must be fitted at time of installation of this set to comply with Building Standard G12/AS1 Acceptable Solution; Protection of Potable Water Supplies from Backflow.

#### **INSTALLATION**

# \*FOR PRESSURES EXCEEDING 500kPa INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE. THOROUGHLY FLUSH ALL PIPES TO ELIMINATE ANY REMAINING DIRT AND RESIDUE, AND INSTALL INLINE FILTERS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY VOID THE WARRANTY.

- Turn off water supply to the existing cistern tap.
- Remove hose from the cistern tap.
- Remove the cistern tap from the wall.
- Attach the 15mm female T connector to the wall connection.
- Fit an additional isolating cistern tap (not included) to the T connector, see diagram.
- Ensure the flow regulator is fitted between the hose and isolating tap.
- Fit a black washer into the handpiece end of the pressure hose, then attach the small, knurled end of the hose to the Isolating tap, and attach long tapered end to the handpiece.
- Fit the original cistern tap to the T piece and reconnect the cistern hose.

## - ENSURE A COMPLIANT BACKFLOW PREVENTION VALVE IS INSTALLED BEFORE TURNING ON MAINS WATER SUPPLY

- Turn on water supply.
- Check for leaks and for proper operation of the handpiece.
- Fit wall bracket in a suitable position using wall anchors, ensuring hose isn't stretched.

IMPORTANT: Turn off the the cistern tap that is connected to the handpiece hose when not in use. Do not submerge handpiece in water.


