

INSTALLATION

FOR PRESSURES EXCEEDING 500KPA INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE. THOROUGHLY FLUSH ALL PIPES TO ELIMINATE ANY REMAINING DIRT AND RESIDUE AND INSTALL INLINE FILTERS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY VOID THE WARRANTY.

- Turn off mains supply.
- Cut 15mm screwed tube to allow for a minimum 15mm wall protrusion and fit hot and cold tub taps. NB: It is essential to apply either Teflon sealing tape or graphite & hemp around the screwed tube prior to installation.
- When attaching the washing machine taps, ensure that the mounting washer is inserted between the coupling nut and washing machine tap inlet spigot. NB: Do not over-tighten nut. Do not rotate washing mchine tap, once mounting nut tightened.
- Ensure the washing machine valves are off if not connected to the appliance, when turning on mains water supply.
- Turn on water supply. Check for leaks.
